Homework Break in West Head

A recent decision by a board of education on the subject of homework has led to strong reactions from various groups. The West Head Education board announced it would be doing a practice 'no-homework' trial for a year beginning in September 2019. The plan will apply to all elementary, junior high and high school students.

Les Hale, spokesperson for the West Head Board, explained, "We have to think about the stress and worries that our youngsters experience these days due to the pressures they face in their lives. When you add homework to the usual school day, children are putting in more hours a week than adults do at work." He added, "We think this move will also allow families more chances to eat at the same time, have fun and make sure their children are getting to bed at a normal time."

Another mother said, "Homework gives children a sense of pride. When they are able to answer homework questions about what they learned at school, their confidence grows.
